

Your Commitment

The Western Health Volunteer Program requires a firm commitment of at least 12 months. Most volunteers commit to a regular weekly or fortnightly shift

A commitment is also required that volunteers should complete at ongoing training sessions each year and be able to maintain a phone, email or face to face relationship with their relevant Volunteer Coordinator.

Williamstown Hospital Opportunity Shop Volunteers assist in managing the resale of donated items through the Williamstown Hospital Opportunity Shop. Volunteers undertake set shifts to ensure that the Opportunity Shop is open for business 7 days a week (with the exception of some Sundays in the winter months and during COVID) and the funds raised are allocated to specific projects within the Williamstown Hospital.

Set shifts are:

9am—11am : Sorting, accepting of donations, pricing, visual merchandise)

11am—3pm : customer service and sales
